As part of the Centenary Year Celebration, CIRCOT Mumbai has organized a Startup Conclave. KRISHIK-ABI, UAS, Dharwad hosted the National Agri Startup Expo (NASE 2024) on December 27-28, 2024. The expo attracted 158 startups from nine states and 14 incubation centers.

It was a convergence of startups from various fields such as food processing and value addition, waste-to-wealth, farm machinery, IoT and apps, livestock medicines and nutrients, and crop



management. The event resulted in a significant number of visitors, with 22 Business-to-Business (B2B) and Business-to-Customer (B2C) connections, as well as valuable VC support.

This event has not only boosted confidence of startup founders but also taken the scale of startups to new heights. I would like to extend my sincere gratitude to all the sponsors, agri-incubation centers, and associated organizations for their support and cooperation in organizing the event. Krishitharanga, a KRISHIK ABI-supported startup from Vijayapura, has secured an order through the Empanelment of OEM for supplying farm machinery and agro-processing units. Recognized for its innovative performance, the startup has developed a solar-powered Chickpea Nipping and Leaves Collective Machine that trims up to 9 acres per day, improving yield by 30% and creating additional farmer income through leaf collection. This milestone highlights the startup's impactful contributions to sustainable and efficient farm mechanization under KRISHIK ABI.

National Agri Startup Expo-24

National Agri Startup Expo-2024 (NASE-24) was organized by KRISHIK-ABI, RKVY-Innovation and Agri entrepreneurship program, University of Agricultural Sciences (UAS), Dharwad on 27 and 28 December 2024 at Farmers Knowledge Centre, UAS Dharwad. This National level Expo provided collaboration & networking opportunities and facilitated B2B and B2C connections to Agri and allied sector startups. Various technical and knowledge sessions were conducted to share the best practices in agriculture and allied sectors.











Commercialization of Innovation: Public Private Partnership, Leveraging B2B marketing, Bridging the Gap: Branding and Digital Integration, Growth Without Burnout- How to Scale your Startup Smartly, Intellectual Property and Patents and Panel discussion on Harnessing Investment Opportunities for Startups were conducted.

In the expo latest technologies, products, and services from innovators, startups and established organizations were exhibited, offering attendees a chance to explore groundbreaking innovations. A total of 158 stalls including 130 Agri and allied related startups (42 Startups on food processing and value addition, 19 Startups on Waste to wealth, 25 Startups on farm mechanization, 17 Startups on IoT and App, 9 Startups on livestock medicines and nutrients, 18 Startups on crop management), 4 Incubators, 10 associated Organizations/sponsors, 10 UAS, Dharwad Technology & Agro Innovate stalls, 4 Registration Desk/B2B Center were arranged.

The expo witnessed visitors from across the country including 153 Incubates/Founders, 502 FPOs, 250 DAESI, (Diploma in Agricultural Extension Services for Input Dealers), 92 Farm Women, 36 Farmers, 58 students and faculty from Farm University, 178 s students and faculty from UAS Dharwad, 1655 students from Engineering & Management colleges and 4500 local visitors from the North Karnataka region.

Each startup stall received an impressive average of 433 visitors over the course of the event. The participating startups collectively generated a total revenue of approximately 5,24,000, showcasing the tangible commercial benefits of the pavilion. O n an average, each startup earned 4,000 during the event. Individual startup's revenue ranged from 1,500 to 40,000. Startups have successfully established 22 Business-to-Business (B2B) and 1104 Business-to-Customer (B2C) connections, paving the way for future collaborations, partnerships, and scaling opportunities. This connection not only contributed to immediate sales but also laid the foundation for long-term brand loyalty and market expansion.

Key aspects reviewed were project effectiveness, documentation standards and the promotion of















X Cohort RIC meeting of KRISHIK-ABI

RIC Meeting of KRISHIK-ABI, UAS Dharwad

The RIC Meeting of KRISHIK-ABI, UAS Dharwad was conducted virtually from 15-17 October 2024, 10:00 am to 1:00 pm. Dr. S. S. Dolli, Principal Investigator and CEO of KRISHIK-ABI and esteemed committee members of the RIC attended the meeting to screen and assess the applicants. A total of 54 applicants comprising of 13 seed-stage, 22 pre-seed startup and 19 student-category startups who presented their innovative ideas were screened for funding and handholding. Based on innovativeness of the ideas, their potential and impact, the committee recommended 23 startups consisting of six seed-stage, 10 pre-seed and 7 student-category startups were selected and recommended for the incubation program.














VIII Cohort SIC online meeting of R-ABI ICAR-CIRCOT, Mumbai

The SIC Meeting of R-ABI, ICAR-CIRCOT, Mumbai, was held on November 21, 2024 to evaluate the VIII cohort incubates. A total of 16 startups made presentations, out of which twostartups were recommended for pre-seed stage funding (UDAY-AOP) with grant-in-aid totaling ₹8.00 lakhs and 14 startups were recommended for seed stage funding (ANKUR-SAIP) with grant-in-aid totaling ₹210.00 lakhs. Two startups from the seed stage funding category were suggested to refine their proposals and present their ideas in the next SIC meeting.
